

Assignment 4: CSS II – Navigation bar III

The Navigation bar is displayed as:

-  [Contact us](#)

In this assignment, we will convert it to horizontal. The output would be similar to:



The above is just an example. You can make any changes you want.

External style sheet

1. Open the file "mystyles.css" in the folder "chocolate/css".
2. Create a class ".navbar". The CSS could be like:

.navbar {  
    list-style-type: ...;  
    margin: ...;  
    padding: ...;  
    font-size: ...;  
}  
.navbar li {display: inline-block;}  
.navbar li a {  
    text-decoration: ...;  
    color: ...;  
    background-color: ...;  
    padding:...;  
}  
.navbar li a:hover {  
    color: ...;  
    background-color: ...;  
    padding:...x;  
}  
.navbar li a.active {  
    color: ...;  
    background-color: ...;  
    padding:...;  
}
```

You can either write the values of the properties shown in the example or create your own properties/values. The colors that have been used in the example are: #F5F5DC, #6E3F19, #F8E9BB and #FCDA92. You can choose your own colors using https://www.w3schools.com/cssref/css_colors.asp or use https://www.w3schools.com/colors/colors_mixer.asp to mix colors.

HTML files

In each HTML file, "index.html, about.html, contact.html":

- update the `<ul>` of the navigation list with the class "navbar" and
- the appropriate `<a>` tag with the class "active". This class refers to the current link and enables the user to know its current page.
